DAY 1

DAY 2




Morning: Kick things off by seeing the Mutianyu Section of the **Great Wall** with the World's foremost Wall historian.

DAY 3



Morning: Engineer your own Mr Miyagi moment with an hour-long **Kung Fu or Tai Chi** in the grounds of the stunning Temple of Heaven with a Shaolin Monk.

Afternoon: Your chance to see the parts of the city most tourists never do: Bespoke's award nominated **Time Chase** is an exhilarating scavenger hunt around the city's hidden historical gems in vintage PLA sidecars (in collaboration with Beijing Sideways).

DAY 4



Morning: Perfect for foodie-families, sample Beijing's tastiest (and least scary) **Street Snacks** in this morning market tour.

Afternoon: With full bellies it's off to **Tiananmen Square** and the jewel in Beijing's crown, **The Forbidden City** to learn about the Emperors.

DAY 5



Morning: Beijing's coolest place by far, the **798 Art District** is bursting with relics from Mao-era Beijing and world-class contemporary art galleries, full of installations and visual delights.

Afternoon: After a hearty lunch you'll board the **bullet train to Shanghai** and settle in to one of Bespoke's recommended hotels - **The Peninsula**, **The Puli** or **The Andaz**.

DAY 6



Morning: Have fun weaving in and out of Shanghai's most beautiful buildings (including the **Bund**) with Bespoke's **Art Deco** expert.

Afternoon: Your chance to explore Shanghai's bustling **former French Concession**, it's most famous parks and it's grand former residences.

Evening: Traveling with teens? Explore the city on a **Night Biking Tour** or take the zany **Bund Tourist Tunnel** across the river for a sky-high drink.
